Recent Major Accomplishments

The Northern Research Station will continue to implement a program that addresses a comprehensive scientific foundation, including the following strategic program directions: Sustaining Forests, Forest Disturbance Processes, Urban Natural Resources Stewardship, Providing Clean Air and Water and Natural Resources Inventory and Monitoring. Within this program direction the scientists in Minnesota have already achieved the following:

 Began a multi-year cooperative effort called "Spruce and Peatland Responses Under Climatic and Environmental Change," or SPRUCE, in northern Minnesota to test the response of northern peatland ecosystems to increased

- temperatures and exposure to elevated carbon dioxide.
- Produced a conservation education DVD that uses traditional Hmong storytelling to deliver key messages.
- Completed an economic assessment in the Twin Cities of damage caused by an invasive alien pathogen that causes oak wilt.
- Worked with state agencies on research into biological control of emerald ash borer.
- Developed a novel automated mapping technique that uses winter satellite imagery to create reliable estimates of forest lands between FIA field plots, allowing customers to more confidently explore forest dynamics beyond the grid of FIA plots.
